What Position Am I Running For?

Serving on Laurier's Senate or Board of Governors provides unique learning and leadership opportunities. Through your participation, you will have an impact on strategic decision-making at the University. Students on Senate and Board are full members, and are required to attend meetings, come prepared, participate, and respect confidentiality. If elected, you will be expected to provide a student perspective while making decisions in the best interest of the University. The [Wilfrid Laurier University Act](#) lays out the powers of both governing bodies. The following is a brief overview of the Board of Governors and Senate, and how students are elected to them.

Senator

The Senate is the highest academic body of WLU and makes decisions on high-level academic issues, such as strategic plans, new program proposals, and curriculum changes. In total, there are seven (7) elected undergraduate positions on Senate with one (1) being dedicated to a student from the Brantford Campus. Senators who are undergraduate students are elected for a two (2) year term, and are expected to serve on at least one of the following committees:

- Academic Planning
- Governance
- Student Appeals
- Executive and Finance
- Teaching and Learning
- Honorary Degree

For a term starting July 1, 2023, there are two undergraduate student vacancies on Senate. One is a full two (2) year term, and one is a partial one (1) year term.

Eligibility: Any Laurier student is eligible to run for Senate; however, they cannot be a member of a student body, staff, or governing body of an external degree-granting institution throughout the duration of their term.

Governor

In total, there are two (2) elected undergraduate positions on the Board of Governors, each elected for a two (2) year term. The Board of Governors is empowered to govern the University, control its property and revenues through matters like the budget, and establish university-wide policies and overall strategic direction. Students are expected to serve on at least one of the following committees:

- Audit, Risk, and Compliance
- Finance, Investment, and Property
- Executive
- Human Resources

For a term starting July 1, 2023, there is one (1) undergraduate student vacancy on the Board of Governors.

Eligibility: Any undergraduate student is eligible to run for the Board of Governors.

You are highly encouraged to do your own research before running, and ensure you can make the time commitment to serve. For more information on the Board of Governors, Senate, their bylaws, past meeting minutes, and meeting schedules, please refer to the governance page on Laurier's [student website](#). Key Dates:

- **Nomination Packages due** – January 6, 2023 at 12:00pm (noon)
- **All Candidates Meeting** – January 8, 2023 at 7:00pm
- **Campaign period** – January 8, 2023 (A half hour following the conclusion of the All Candidates Meeting) to January 24, 2023 at 7:30 am
- **Voting Days** – January 24, 2023 at 8:00am to January 26, 2023 at 8:00pm.
- **Results Night** – January 26, 2023 at 9:00pm.

Expenditures and Reimbursements:

Candidates for Board of Governors or Senate are limited to expenses, sponsorships, and gifts-in-kind totalling **\$50**.

The Chief Returning Officer or their designate must approve in advance all promotional materials used for campaigning, regardless of the medium.

Candidates will be reimbursed for 100% of approved campaign expenses, unless the maximum allowable limit is surpassed.

Candidates are required to submit receipts in order for campaign materials to be reimbursed.

Candidates who wish to utilizing posters on campus for campaigning are limited to a maximum of **50** copies (You are responsible for following Laurier's poster policy and for removing all posters following the election).

All social media platforms (accounts) intended for campaigning and promotional use must be declared, approved, and registered with the Chief Returning Officer, or their designate prior to use.

****It is your responsibility to review the 2023 Election Policy in detail to understand all campaigning and expenditure guidelines, and the process for demerits and appeals****
