



# FACULTY ACADEMIC APPEALS



# **CAN I APPEAL?**

You can appeal a decision if it affects your academic standing, and you believe it was made unfairly OR if you believe you should receive consideration for extenuating circumstances

### WHEN CAN I APPEAL?

You must file your petition within **6 weeks** of the decision in question

# WHAT IS A PETITION FORM?

Each Faculty has an individualized appeal process, including a specialized <u>petition form</u>

The petition form will ask you to indicate what you are appealing, and give you an opportunity to make your case through a personal statement and any included supporting documentation (e.g. medical note)

### **HOW DO I APPEAL?**

Submit a completed <u>petition form</u> to the office of the dean of your registered faculty

**Grade appeals** should be submitted to the chair of the department for that course

Lazaridis students should submit to the faculty's petitions coordinator



# THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF APPEALS THAT YOU CAN MAKE TO A FACULTY PETITIONS COMMITTEE



ON THE GROUNDS THAT THE NORMAL FACULTY OR UNIVERSITY RULES/PROCEDURES WERE NOT PROPERLY APPLIED

ON THE GROUNDS OF EXTENUATING CIRCUMSTANCES

You must demonstrate in writing (on the petition form) that in your circumstance a university rule, or an <a href="Academic Calendar">Academic Calendar</a> requirement or regulation, was not followed properly or applied fairly

You must indicate in writing (on the petition form) what relief you seek from the faculty or university rules, or <u>Academic Calendar</u> requirements and regulations, as a result of extenuating circumstances (e.g. illness or bereavement)

# **RULINGS**

There is no guarantee that your petition will be approved. Each faculty's **Petitions and Regulations Committee** takes into consideration what is in your best interest, and what is fair and equitable for all students and allowable under **Senate** regulations

Your appeal will be considered within six weeks of filing and you will be advised of the decision in writing to your MyLaurier account

### **FURTHER APPEALS**

You may appeal the decision of the faculty petitions committee to the **Senate Student Appeals Committee**, in accordance with the <u>Procedures for Considering Appeals</u> by the Senate Student Appeals Committee
