Policy, Risk Management Policy

1. Purpose

1.1. This policy sets out the process for forming and participating in any undergraduate student club or faculty association.

2. Definitions

- **2.1. Academic term**: The Fall, Winter, or Spring/Summer semesters as defined by the Wilfrid Laurier University Undergraduate Academic Calendar.
- **2.2. Club(s)**: References to a "club" or "clubs" indicate guidelines that are inclusive of both Students' Union clubs and faculty-based clubs.
- **2.3. Faculty Association**: A group that collects a dedicated student levy to fund discipline-specific initiatives and operations, including Faculty-based clubs.
- **2.4. Faculty-based club:** A discipline-specific sub-group of Faculty Associations.
- **2.5. Students' Union-Based club (SU-Based Clubs):** The Students' Union Campus Clubs fee funds opportunities for groups to form around common interests, including social justice, mental health, entrepreneurship, and personal faith.
- **2.6. Undergraduate Calendar:** The Wilfrid Laurier University Academic Calendars contains official information regarding program requirements, course offerings, and academic regulations. There are three academic calendars: undergraduate, graduate, and part-time/online learning/continuing education.

3. Jurisdiction/Scope

3.1. This policy applies to all Wilfrid Laurier University undergraduate students, and all faculty associations, faculty-based clubs, and Students' Union clubs.

4. Policy

4.1. All Wilfrid Laurier University undergraduate students are eligible to be members of Students' Union clubs if they are a member of the Students' Union in good standing and



- have paid all relevant fees.
- **4.2.** All Wilfrid Laurier University undergraduate students are eligible to be members of their Faculty Association or a Faculty-based club if they are a member of the Students' Union in good standing and have paid all relevant fees.
- **4.3.** All Wilfrid Laurier University undergraduate students who have paid all relevant fees are eligible to submit a new club application.
 - **4.3.1.** New club applications submitted on The Nest are assessed during two review periods, as specified by the Vice-President: Clubs & Associations ahead of the Fall and Winter terms.
- **4.4.** SU-Based Clubs are eligible to operate as Multi-Campus Clubs so long as they run at least one (1) programmed event on each Laurier campus with enrolled undergraduate students during the academic year and maintain a co-president executive structure.
- **4.5.** Clubs must maintain "active status" as defined and outlined by the *Clubs & Associations Procedures Manual.*
- **4.6.** Clubs must maintain a membership of at least twenty (20) undergraduate student members on the Waterloo campus, ten (10) undergraduate student members on the Brantford campus, and twenty (20) undergraduate student members for multi-campus groups, with a minimum of five (5) members on each campus.
- **4.7.** Faculty-based club memberships must include a majority (50% plus one) of students from that faculty
- 4.8. Executive members of faculty associations and faculty-based clubs must be students registered in programs of study in that faculty as defined by the Undergraduate Calendar;
 4.8.1. An exception may be considered for students registered in double degree programs.
- **4.9.** Clubs and faculty associations must facilitate all financial exchanges and dealings through the Students' Union finance department, and hold all monies within a designated Students' Union registered bank account.
- **4.10.** Clubs and faculty associations must submit an event request form on The Nest at least three (3) weeks prior to the event date.
- **4.11.** Any club or faculty association that requires, or plans to establish a third-party affiliation, must complete an "External Affiliation Application" prior to formalizing this relationship.
- **4.12.** Any club or faculty association that requires, or plans to establish a formal advisory relationship with a Wilfrid Laurier University faculty or staff member, must complete a "Clubs and Associations Advisor Agreement" in advance.
- **4.13.** Clubs and faculty associations may partner with similar student groups at the University of Waterloo or Conestoga College on a limited term basis as approved by the (A)VP: Clubs & Associations.
- **4.14.** All clubs and faculty associations seeking sponsorships must first complete the *Clubs & Associations Department Sponsorship Agreement* form.
- **4.15.** All clubs and faculty associations must abide by the *Clubs and Associations Procedures Manual*, all policies and procedures of the Students Union, the <u>Student Code of Conduct and Discipline</u>, the <u>Student Non-Academic Code of Conduct</u>, all other applicable



university rules, policies, and regulations; and obey municipal bylaws, the laws of the Province of Ontario, and the laws of Canada.
